This week, students in Years 3 and 5 will bring home their NAPLAN results. We encourage parents to read the reports and contact the school if they have any questions. Remember the NAPLAN tests are a snap shot in time. At school, NAPLAN results are used in a collaboration with student school-based assessment to support teacher programming and student achievement records.

I ask that parents support the morning playground supervision to ensure all students are visible to the teacher on duty. Supervision is available from 8:30am at which time all students (including those whose parents remain at school) are to be seated on the silver seats outside the hall. Late Arrivals to School

Smithfield Public School begins at 9:00am each day and your child's most valuable learning time is at the start of the day. We have updated our attendance policy and the procedures for following up the late arrival of students. The classroom teacher will record when children arrive between 9:00am and 9:10am, their late arrival. Children arriving after 9:10am must get a late note from the office.

Parents/carer must provide a valid explanation when children arrive at school after 9:10am. This can be done by:

- Writing a note.
- 2. Accompanying your child to the office and providing a verbal explanation to the office staff.

Starting this week, in the first instance of a child arriving at school without an explanation, the office staff will phone their parent/carer to seek an explanation. In the second instance, the office staff will phone parents and remind them of the school policy. In the third instance, the principal or deputy principal will follow up the child's late arrival.
