



Core Lesson			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Give students a map of the school and have them mark the out of bounds areas (have students work in pairs or small groups). Share results. Then display and discuss the correct out of bounds areas map. Go on a treasure hunt identifying out of bounds areas. The treasure can be at your discretion but must be placed in bounds to reinforce where students should be. Go for a walk around the school and identify the out of bounds areas drawing attention to the yellow lines. 			
Additional Lessons			
Sample Lesson 1 Discuss areas that we play at recess and lunch. Reinforce that students are not to go to classrooms at recess and lunch without their classroom teachers permission. Make links to consequences for being out of bounds.			
Sample Lesson 2 Each morning discuss in bounds areas. Pop quiz relating to in bounds and out of bounds areas.
