Important Information

Kiss and Drop Zones

These zones are designed for your convenience and for your child's safety. Designed for quick entry and exit, these zones minimise congestion and risk when used properly by all parents and carers. These zones operate under the same conditions as no parking zones, which means you may stop to drop or pick up children for a maximum of 2 minutes. You're required to remain in, or within 3 metres of, your vehicle.

Ways to improve your child's safety

When walking with your children, talk to them about safe crossing procedures and traffic safety regulations. Make sure they keep to the crossing and not veer onto the road. Set a good example. Parents and carers are the best road safety teachers. Teach your children to be aware of the traffic environment: distractions such as wearing headphones or playing with friends on the way to or from school can make them more vulnerable to dangers. Never call your child across the road.

In and out of the car safely

Ensure your child gets in and out of the car through the **safety door**. This is the rear kerb-side door of the car. Your child should remain in the car until an adult opens the safety door. Help your child buckle up. Make sure their seatbelt is not twisted. It is a good habit to make sure all passengers are securely buckled into a child seat, booster seat or seatbelt before you start the car.
