Class Visits

This term I had the pleasure of working in Stage one classes. I enjoyed exploring 2D and 3D shapes with 2J and 2S. In both classes, students demonstrated curiosity and used questioning to further their inquiries. In 1A, I enjoyed helping students write informing texts which explained the process of a caterpillar becoming a butterfly. The students' use of technical language was impressive. In 2W, I supported students to work collaboratively to share their knowledge of butterflies and mealworms through the development of informing posters. It was pleasing to see students refer back to the success criteria to ensure their poster included all of the required language features of an informing text. In 1L, I was impressed with students' ability to use 'bridging 10' to solve number equations. They worked in groups to learn about number combinations to make 10. Other groups then applied this knowledge to solve equations. Next term, I look forward
