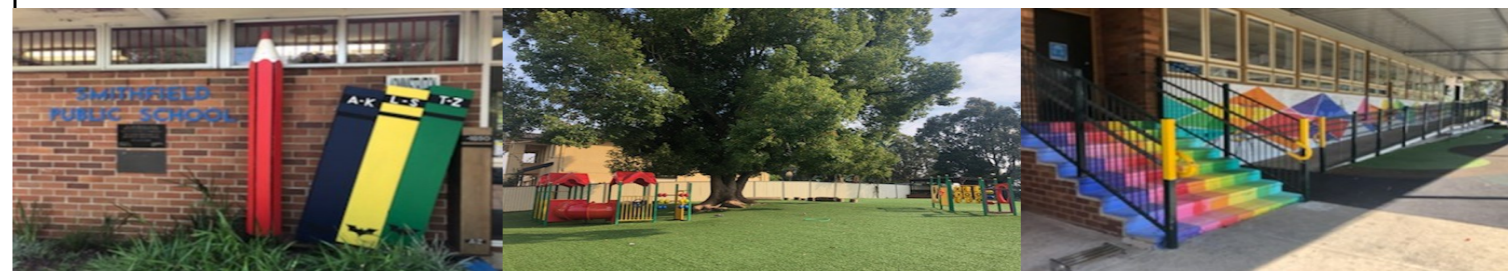
Smithfield Public School Newsletter

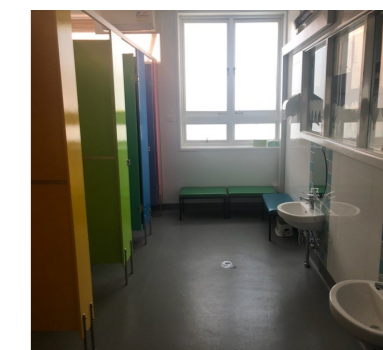
EIU Bathroom Upgrade
